








### What is the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite?













#### What is the Purpose of the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite?

- > Seek what is the most worth in the world
- Supplement and Amplify the philosophical teachings of the first three degrees.
- Exalt the dignity of every person, the human side of our daily activities, and the maximum service to humanity;
- Aid mankind's search in God's universe for identity, for development and for destiny, and thereby achieve better men in a better world, happier men in a happier world and wiser men in a wiser world.











#### The History of the Ancient & Accepted Scottish Rite

- 1730 Evidence in England there were "Scotch Masons" or "Scots Master Masons," a step after the Master Mason Degree (and apparently unrelated to Scotland).
- 1742 In Berlin there was talk of "higher or so-called Scottish Masonry".
- 1743 The Grand Lodge of France adopted a regulation limiting the privileges of "Scots Masters" in lodges
- 1756 The Council of the Knights of the East, Sovereign Prince Masons in France
- 1758 Sovereign Council of Emperors of the East and of the West, Sublime Scottish Mother Lodge in France formed
- 1761 Stephen Morin received a patent from the Grand Lodge of France "authorizing and empowering him to establish perfect and sublime Masonry in all parts of the world
  - There were some 25 High Degrees during this time period.











#### The History of the Ancient & Accepted Scottish Rite

1801 – 1<sup>st</sup> Supreme Council in USA established in Charleston, South Carolina "The Southern Jurisdiction ALASR"



- The Mother Council of the World
- Declared its existence with a motto of "Ordo ab Chao" (Order from Chaos).
- Degrees increased to 32 (Albert Pike 33°) and the 33° as the governing body
- 1806 2<sup>nd</sup> Supreme Council in USA established in New York "The Northern Jurisdiction ACLASR"



1868 – Scottish Rite Bodies founded in Canada

1874 - Supreme Council of Canada inaugurated in Ottawa, ON









#### The Scottish Rite Charitable Foundation of Canada

- Registered Foundation with Revenue Canada under Letters Patent of Incorporation (1964)
- The Foundation labours for the benefit of all Canadians, regardless of race or creed.
- > Supports research into the "puzzles of the mind"
  - Learning Centres across Canada providing free tutoring to children who have been formal identified as Dyslexia
  - > 8 Learning Centres in Canada London, Windsor, Halifax, Barrie, Vancouver, Moncton, Calgary & Edmonton
  - > Over \$400,000 in Grant Monies presented annually for research











#### The 3 Bodies of Scottish Rite

- > Lodge of Perfection
  - > Conferring or communicating the degrees from the 4° to the 14°
- Chapter of Rose Croix
  - Conferring or communicating the degrees from the 15° to the 18°
- Consistory
  - Conferring or communicating the degrees from the 19° to the 32°
- Responsibilities of Each Body
  - Elect and Appoint its own Officers
  - > Oversee the finances of the Valley
  - Conferring a specific number of degrees











#### How are the Scottish Rite Degrees Conferred?

- The first 3 Degrees of Masonry conferred in each of the Grand Lodge Jurisdictions across Canada are recognized by the A. & A. S. R.
- Confers or communicates all degrees from the fourth (4°) to the thirty-second (32°) degrees
- > Theatrical dramas and lectures appeal to both the ear and eye
- Plays are often staged with costumes, scenery, or even special effects
- > NO memory work for the candidates
- Each degree teaches different Lessons and Duties for the true Initiate











#### In Conclusion
